Almost all stoneflies emerge by crawling from the water, there is no emerging stage to imitate. They do h mayflies. That is why a longer shank hook will be necessary to imitate them.

There are 2 things to remember when selecting hooks. First the size number is and indication of the gap between the shank and the point. Any size hook can be found in many different shank lengths. The shall length needs to match the size of the insect you are trying to imitate. In general, when a hook size is indicate a shank length that will be approximately the right size for the insect.
